Community Engagement Resources

One of the underlying themes throughout the Advocacy Areas of Focus is **children building and preserving connections with family and others.** As CASAs, we focus on preserving caring and competent connections and ensuring a child's mental, physical, social and educational developmental needs are met. Helping the child build relationships which may be outside their immediate world can be critical in making friends and interacting with others in a respectful/fun manner, i.e., learning to function in society, stopping the increase of ACEs and promoting resilience.

As ACES training taught us, competent community involvement is a protective factor against ACEs and is invaluable in offsetting/counteracting the negative experiences in a child's life. Community Organizations play a critical role in connecting young people with positive role models and providing activities for them to learn leadership, self-regulation, being able to disagree respectfully and productively, etc. Positive childhood experiences, such as community connection, act as protective factors and significantly reduce the odds of adult depression or mental health problems.
